National Phase Validation of Granted EP Patents

The centralized, fundamentally autonomous and uniform procedure for the grant of European patents, introduced by the European Patent Convention (EPC), is linked in a special way with the national patent law of the member states of the European Patent Organisation, and at a number of stages it interfaces with the national legal systems - a feature essential to smooth interaction between European and national law. In each of the contracting states for which it is granted, the European patent has the effect of and is subject to the same conditions as a national patent granted by that state.

National law of the EPC member states requires certain steps which have to be performed according to the rules of the national Patent Offices. For example, translations into the official languages, if applicable with regard to the London Agreement, have to be filed and national fees must be paid to the authorities.
